Down King's Hunting Trail

Čvrsnica Mountain: Žljeb – Tise

Category: Moderate

Activity: 4-5 hours walking (1000m ascent)

Period: April to November

Departure: From your accommodation site at 8:00am where our guide with your transport vehicle will be greeting and transporting you to your starting point.

Return: 5:00pm to your accommodation site

Included: Transport from Mostar to the starting point of mountain trail and back, English speaking, fully equipped, and experienced mountain guide.

Price: 40 EUR/person, price based on minimum 3 persons. For 2 persons or less individual price for the trip may be set or merger with another group might be organized if possible.

To bring: Hiking boots or sturdy sneakers, medium backpack, minimum 1 l of water, light sandwich, rain coat, spare shirt, sun hat and sun protection crème.

Čvrsnica Mountain, as a part of mountains representing Dinaric extension of the Swiss Alps, is located in northern Herzegovina. It has more than ten summits above 2000 m. Its highest peak – Pločno (2228masl) is actually the highest mountain peak in all Herzegovina and bears the name „Herzegovina's roof top". Čvrsnica also hides beautiful lakes: Blidinje, Crepulja and Crvenjak. Its bio-life is characteristic with numerous endemic species (like Munika Pine) and is also known as a home of chamois.

We find it as the ideal place for all those who desire silence, wilderness and mountain peacefulness, complemented only with sounds of wind and hidden forest inhabitants.

The hike

Down King's Hunting Trail 1 day hike is a stunning tour through the refreshing forests of Čvrsnica Mountain to Žljeb and Tise. You have the opportunity to experience nature and as well to be a part of history while trekking on King Karadjordjevic's old hunting trails. While the King passed away quite a while ago, we are fortunate to keep his trail very much alive. From amazing Diva Grabovica valley, we will hike through colorful beech-tree forests. The trail leads us to several natural springs, nowadays so rare fresh and icy water where we can refill our bottles for our final ascent.

After approximately 2.5-hour climb, we will reach our destination overlooking the largest rock face on the Balkan Peninsula at over 1,000 meters. This tour brings you to breathtaking and spectacular views that we are sure you will memorize with a selfie or two, so experience your adventure and be sure to bring your good spirit.
